## Minutes of the Meeting of Central SBF Committee held at HQ-CCG on 15.02.2022

The Member Secretary cum Dy.CPO (Wel) extended a warm welcome to the Co-Chairman and all Members of the Central Committee.

Minutes on Agenda items:

1. **Sanction of funds in addition to 8.55 lakhs already sanctioned for procurement of items for the T-55 Building** – the request sent by JRH for an additional amount of Rs.1,29,739 was not agreed to. The Committee desired to know the reasons for variation in the rates of items as the time span between the date of proposal by JRH and the date of procurement is not long.
2. **Procurement of Semi-Automatic Analyzer for HAPA Health Unit – RJT division** – This being a medical machine, should be procured from out of Railway revenues. Hence, not agreed to.
3. **Children play equipment for the gardens in railway colonies of RTM Division** – The Committee agreed that 4 items, namely, swing (jhoola), see-saw, merry-go-round and sliding scale (fisalan patti) should be sanctioned as standard equipment for children play in railway colony parks. Only where the colony has large number of quarters, more than

one of these items can be sanctioned by the Chairman. Divisions should send any estimate for these 4 items, avoid fancy items and where more than one such item is required, should give justification for the same.

4. **Gym Equipment** - The Committee decided that standard items for open Gym should be as provided to the open Gym in the Valsad Railway colony. Similar items should only be provided for new open-air Gyms.
5. **Shraddhanjali Grant** - Members raised the issue of non-sanction of Shraddhanjali grant to one case by Parel Workshop and requested the Chair to examine the reference received from the workshop. Members suggested to modify the Shraddhanjali Scheme to the effect that the grant of Rs. 20000/- should be available to the family of every staff expiring at duty place during hours of duty, whether due to accident or otherwise and without reference to the carrying of the body to the hometown/native place of the staff, i.e., out of the station of death. This will be examined with reference to the objectives and the language of the existing scheme.
6. The Committee decided that a survey of Hotels for renting 2 to 3 rooms as Holiday Home should be done at Tarkarli and Goa on 23<sup>rd</sup> February 2022 by a team of members comprising Sarv Shri G R Verma-WREU, C.R. Iyer-WRMS, O.P.Birwa-AISCSTREA & Ramnath Patil, AIOBCREA and one Staff & Welfare Inspector.
7. **Tentative time for next meeting** - around last week of March 2022.
