Sub: - Stagnation of Pay at maximum of a Level in Pay Matrix.

Consequent to implementation of 7th CPC pay structure, few Railway(s) and recognized Staff Federations referred the cases of staff (primarily disabled/medically unfit running staff on being appointed against alternative post (stationary) posts) whose pay have been stagnating at maximum stage of Level in Pay Matrix. The issue after examination referred to Ministry of Finance with the proposal to grant of increment(s) to such staff.

2. Ministry of Finance after examination has **not** agreed to Ministry of Railways' proposal. Keeping in view of the same, Zonal Railways/PUs are advised to take necessary action as per advice tendered by Ministry of Finance and grievances of concerned staff may be disposed accordingly.
