



#### **REFERENCE TO RAILWAY BOARD BY AIRF**

GS-AIRF vide letter No.AIRF/56(104) dated 24.3.2023 addressed to the DG (HR) Railway Board on the Railway Board letter No.2022/E(LR)III/FAC/02 dated 16.3.2023 by which delegated the power GM to DRM's in regard to transfer of the Office Bearers of recognized trade unions. AIRF has strongly opposed the delegation of power to DRM in regard to transfer of the Office Bearers of recognized trade Unions as it would create disputes and jeopardize industrial relations with the Recognized Unions.

GS-AIRF vide letter No. AIRF/159 dated 28.3.2023 addressed to the DG (HR) Railway Board for providing resting facility for the AC Escorting staff in the Running Rooms all over the Indian Railways.

GS-AIRF vide letter No. AIRF/78(118) dated 7.4.2023 addressed to The Secretary € Railway Board on irregular imposition of conditions for implementation of cadre restructuring in the category of Track Maintainers.

GS-AIRF vide letter No.AIRF/PNM/1/2023 dated 17.4.2023 addressed to the Member (Traction & Rolling Stock) Railway Board has brought out the difficulties to be faced by the Train Managers due to provision of 900mm height Dog Box in the new Power Cars LWLRRM and retro-fitment of Dog Box in existing LWLRRM Power Cars.

GS-AIRF vide letter No.AIRF/PNM/55/2018 dated 20.4.2023 addressed to the PED (IR) Railway Board demanded for grant of three sets of Privilege Passes annually to all the Non-Gazetted Staff from the first day of their appointment in the Railways without any embargo of five year service. This issue is under discussion vide PNM Item No.55/2018 with Railway Board.

GS-AIRF vide letter No.AIRF/101 (28) dated 22.4.2023 addressed to The DG (HR) Railway Board has demanded for grant of Qualification Pay to Nursing Personnel with the approval of concerned Nodal Ministry (Ministry of Health & Family Welfare) with effect from 1.1.2016 from the date of implementation of 7th CPC recommendations.

#### **REFERENCE BY NC-JCM**

GS-AIRF & Secretary –NC- JCM vide letter No. NC/JCM/2023 dated 29.3.2023 addressed to the Special Secretary (Personnel) Ministry of Finance, New Delhi has demanded for grant another chance for option for fixation of pay on promotion and financial up-gradation under MACPS from the date of increment under Rule 10 of the CCS(RP) Rules 2016.

GS-AIRF & Secretary –NC- JCM vide letter No. NC/JCM/2023 dated 1.4.2023 addressed to Hon'ble Minister of Labour & employment (Government of India) New Delhi has demanded for restoration of the defined Old Pension Scheme in place of NPS for the Government employees.

#### RAILWAY BOARD ORDERS

Railway Board vide its letter No. E (GP) 2022/2/4 dated 6.3.2023 in continuation to its letter dated 28.6.2022 circulated that, 70% Selection & 30% LDCE for promotion to Group 'B' posts in organized departments shall be conducted by CBT. Further decided that for the viva-voce conducted as part of 30% LDCE held for promotion to Group 'B' posts candidates should be called to the extent of 5 times the number of respective vacancies.

Railway Board vie its letter No.2023/H-1/19/01/AIRF dated 20.03.20232 has agreed to provide Railway Medical facilities to Quasi Administrative Office staff and other categories of staff who are eligible to take treatment as per IRMM 2000 but cannot be issued UMID card. It has been decided that these staff may continue avail Railway Medical facilities on old medical card under temporary registration in HMIS.

Railway Board vide RBE No.53/2023 dated 13.4.2023 have conveyed its decision and reiterated that, all transfer cases may be processed on priority wherever feasible and all mutual transfer cases pending for NOC



may be finalized on priority.

Railway Board vide RBE No.59/2023 dated 24.4.2023 has conveyed its decision that, Government employees serve as main care giver of dependent daughter / son / parents / spouse/brother/sister with specified disability may be exempted from exercise of routine transfer.
