Sub: Filling up of vacancies against GDCE Notification No.01/2023- exemption of minimum service and extension of Cut-off date for eligibility.

The administration has invited applications from eligible employees for filling up of vacancies notified against GDCE Notification No.01/2023 dated 31-07-2023. As per the notification serving regular employees of Western Railway who have successfully completed period of Probation as on 01-7-2023 are become eligible for the posts. Opening date for application was 02-08-2023 and closing date was 31-08-2023. As a result, large number of newly recruited employees through RRC were found to be ineligible due to the cut-off date.

As per the directives of Railway Board, RRB-Kolkatta held the Centralized CBT on 15-12-2023 subsequently the CBT was cancelled and Railway Board has formed a committee to look into the issues encountered during the conduct of GDCE held on 15-12-2023. As per the recommendation of committee the board has waived the condition of common CBT and permitted Zonal Railways to hold the GDCE examination at their own level vide RBE No.25/2024 dated 15-03-2024.

In this context it is submitted that large number of employees joined in Western Railway after the earlier cut-off date of 01-07-2021 and 01-07-2023 should be made eligible to apply as a fresh as the Railway Board has waived off minimum service condition for filling up of GDCE vacancies.

You are therefore requested to revise the Notification No.01/2023 dated 31-07-2023 issued for filling up of vacancies of ALP, Technician-III, JE, Train Manager by exempting the eligibility condition of minimum service with a fresh cut-off date so that maximum number of posts can be filled up.
