Our cadre have enthusiastically held the protest meetings at the length and breadth of Western Railway. I have attended the 23rd AGM of WCREU held at Bhopal on 09-11-2025 and 71st AGM of NRMU (Central Railway) held at Ratnagiri on 12-11-2025 and addressed the gathering in the open session at both the occasions. I have attended the 25th General Body Meeting of AIRF Women's wing held at Kolkatta on 06-11-2025 the leaders and delegates deliberated various issues faced by the Women employees in railways.

The Ruling Government have passed the newly introduced Labour Codes in the Rajya Sabha and the Parliament of India despite the objections of opposition parties. These Labour Codes will have a severe impact on the working class especially in the unorganized sector. The Central Trade Unions and Sectoral Federations/Associations have called for a General Strike on 12-02-2026 against the Labour Codes and Multi-prong attack on the people right and entitlements by the Central Government.

101st AGM of AIRF held at Northern Railway Stadium, Charbagh, Lucknow on 22-12-2025 which have been unanimously passed 9 Resolutions. Brief report of the AGM is published in this issue. Large number of employees including youth and women from all over India have attended the AGM. In the delegate session of the meeting Com.
